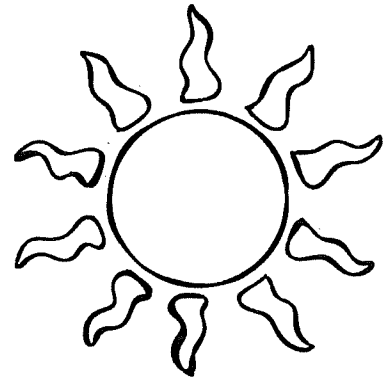


Dear Families,

As we begin to look ahead to next school year, we are excited to welcome our current Fourth grade students to Fifth Grade at Saint Teresa School!



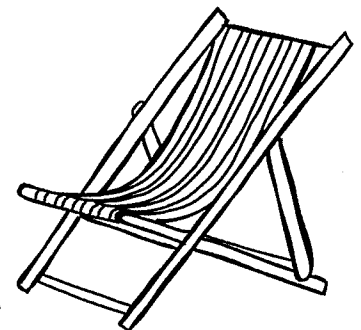

Completing these assignments during the summer will ensure continued success and growth. We've also included a supply list and other learning activities that your student can do over the summer.

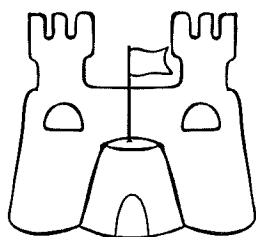

5th Grade Supply List

PLEASE NOTE: Supplies often need to be replenished throughout the school year, but it is helpful if students begin with a reasonable amount, then bring more as needed.
