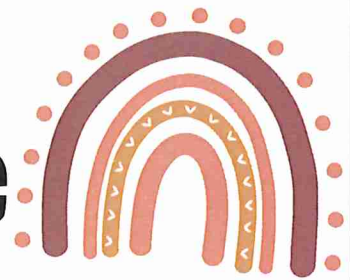


Welcome to **3rd & 4th Grade**

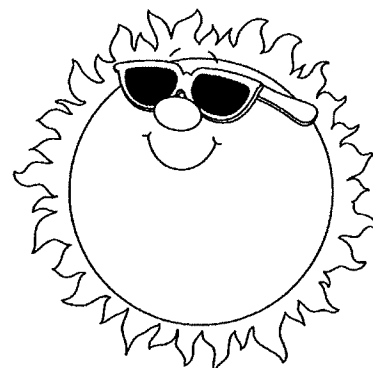

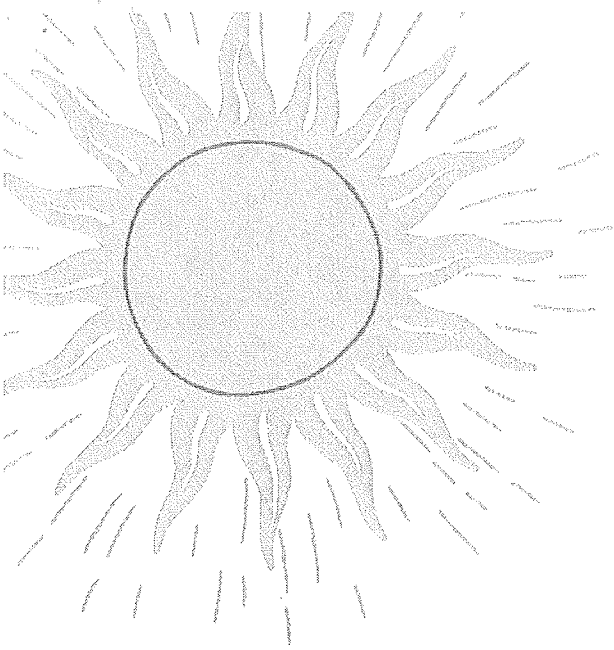


Completing these assignments during the summer will ensure continued success and growth. I've also included a supply list and other learning activities your student can do over the summer.

I hope you have an amazing summer break!

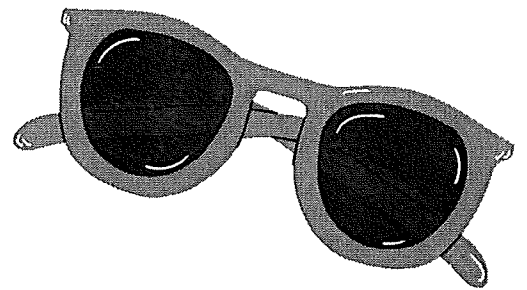

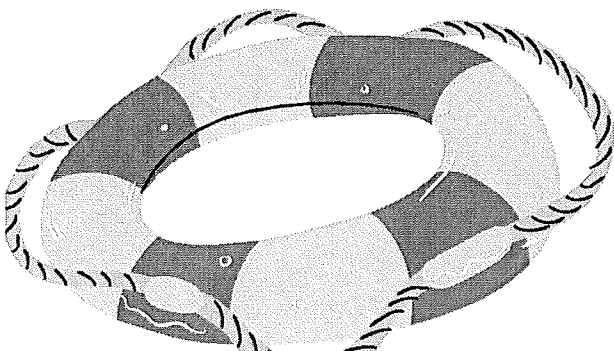

Please choose one book from the list below to read over summer break. Fill out the organizer and write a 5-8 sentence summary and return by the first day of school! Happy Reading!



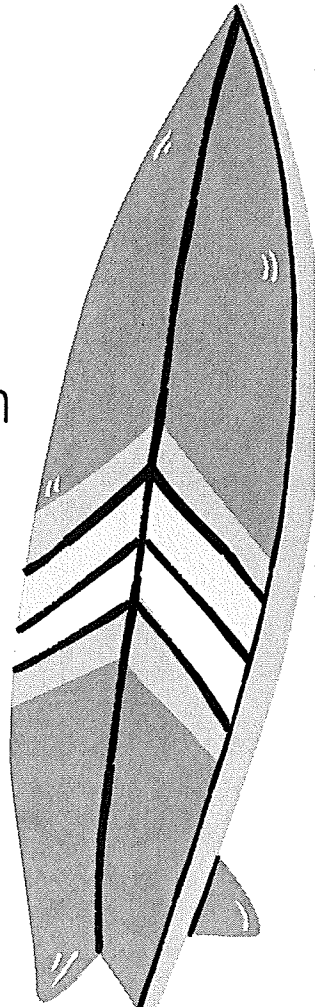
